Fees: First time attendees: \$400. \$100 due with the application & balance due after acceptance.

Participants that have attended Will's Hope previously: \$1,500.00 due with the application.

At least 5-6 young adults are required for any young adult programs to run. Women & men are in separate programs. The Advanced Programs, which are open to qualified returning participants, require higher physical fitness standards & higher academic skills. Potential participants are able to hike 5 miles with an elevation gain of at least 1,000 feet & meet other prerequisites prior to acceptance for the Advanced Programs.

Regular Program attendees must be able to hike 3 miles with an elevation gain of 600 feet. Regular programs are open to first-time attendees as well as previous attendees.

Vision

To serve higher functioning young adults with emotional, cognitive, autism, mental illness & related disabilities or conditions. Will's Hope (WH) uses the outdoors, nature & Native Americans as self-enabling and self-discovery mechanisms for growth and self-development. WH provides opportunities for strengthening individuals and fostering the development of passions, self-confidence, positivity and other intangibles. Potential participants are in the approximate age range of 18 to 30+ years old. Small group size facilitates participant success. Mentors are assigned to each participant.

Mission

Provide young adults with disabilities or related conditions a supportive atmosphere & opportunities to see their situation in a positive way, while using the outdoors, nature & Native Americans as self-enabling and self-discovery mechanisms which may:

- Improve or develop personal awareness, skills, passions & strengths,
- Cultivate individual strengths to see their value to their family, community and humanity,
- Build self-esteem, self-confidence, capabilities for independence, self-advocacy, resiliency of spirit and communication skills,
- Infuse & strengthen "Hope" in each person,
- Promote growth, self-development & leadership,
- Empower participants to see the good in themselves and the good in the world.

Will's Hope takes place in the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem (GYE) in partnership with multiple organizations and native tribes. As a participant you will be able to witness & learn about one of the world's most diverse regions.
